Here is a copy of an email I've just sent to Local Mobility, Leigh, Lancs "Hi Paul, I made a special journey to your shop yesterday, from the Scottish borders to Leigh, just so that I could try out the Luggie scooter. I had been researching it on the internet for some time and it appeared to be what I wanted for holiday travel but I was a bit sceptical and I could not find a scooter nearer to look at. You very kindly allowed me to use your demonstrator and I managed, without difficulty to climb the ramp of a nearby car park with it. In fact, I was so impressed with the build quality and it's great folding design that I bought one. I charged the battery last night and I noted that the battery only reaches maximum power after 10-15 charges. In spite of this, with 70% charge, I took the Luggie for a test run today and was very pleased with it. On the way home (we live at the bottom a a very steep hill), I decided to test the Luggie again. I decided to attempt to climb the hill with it. I was a bit doubtful if it would work, I am 15 stone and it is a steep hill but I needn't have worried - the Luggie performed admirably. So impressed was I, that I also decided to try it up the drive to the house, not so steep, but made made of compressed aggregate, ridged track, muddy in places and rather slippery. Again, NAE BOTHER! Up the drive, across some loose gravel and onto the patio! The Luggie truly is a uniquely capable machine and my next major test with it is when I go to Crete in April. I shall do so confident in it's portabilty and capability. It was a pleasure doing business with you and thank you for a wonderful machine.
